

## CENTENNIAL CAMP 100 CHARITABLE FUND

In accordance with Section 170 of the Internal Revenue Code, there is established a separate charitable activities fund. This fund shall be known as the "Centennial Camp 100 Charitable Fund". This fund shall be organized to meet the requirements of Section 501c3 and will be used exclusively to fund the charitable, educational or literary activities of the Camp in accordance with the purposes set forth in the Congressional Charter (36 U.S.C. 2003) of the Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War (SUVCW). Projects supported by this fund must be approved by a majority vote of the Camp. Upon dissolution of the fund, any remaining balance will be donated to a similarly organized fund of the Department of Colorado and Wyoming, SUVCW; the SUVCW National organization; or the SUVCW Charitable Foundation. Upon dissolution of the Camp, any remaining balance in this fund will be disposed of as required by the Constitution and Regulations of the SUVCW with the provision that it not be used to support the general purposes of the organization.

Passed by the members of Centennial Camp 100, Department of Colorado & Wyoming, SUVCW assembled in its annual business meeting, 29 January 2012.
